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- Dyslexia is a learning disability which affects skills involved in reading, spelling and writing.
- Children suffering from Dyslexia experience difficulty in reading, memorizing and identifying words.
- The main cause is not yet known but it is considered to be a genetic disorder by the experts.
- There is no specified treatment for dyslexia but the child can be helped with tutoring by using apt educational approaches and techniques.
- If it is detected at young age and precautions are taken, the child is assured of leading a normal life. Otherwise he will remain in a miserable state.
- Diagnosis doesn't require lab test or imaging.
- It requires special training for the teachers to detect Dyslexia in children
- Ramakrishna Mission, Vijayawada / Sitanagaram is arranging a 6-day Training Program to handle children suffering from Dyslexia with the help of Madras Dyslexia Association, Chennai.
- Duration: The training program is for 6 days from 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019 to 11<sup>th</sup> May 2019. The schedule is given below in the table. There will be 15 minutes tea breaks and 30 minutes lunch break.
- Target Participants: The training is for teachers handling classes from **KG to Primary (up to class 5)**.
- The sessions would be done in **English**.

- A certificate would be provided at the end of the 6 day training session
